14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND
15	That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
16	Article – Criminal Law

18	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
19	INDICATED.
20	(2) "EDUCATIONAL FACILITY" INCLUDES:



- 1 (I) AN ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL AND THE 2 SURROUNDING GROUNDS; AND
- 3 (II) AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION AS DEFINED IN § 4 10–101 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.
- 5 "MEDICAL FACILITY" INCLUDES:
- 6 (I) A FACILITY AS DEFINED IN § 10–101 OF THE 7 HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE;
- 8 (II) A HEALTH CARE FACILITY AS DEFINED IN § 19–114 OF THE 9 HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE; AND
- 10 (III) AN AGENCY, A CLINIC, OR AN OFFICE OPERATED UNDER THE 11 DIRECTION OF THE LOCAL HEALTH OFFICER OR UNDER THE REGULATORY
- 12 AUTHORITY OF THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.
- 13 (4) "PLACE OF WORSHIP" MEANS A NONRESIDENTIAL LOCATION
- 14 WHERE MORE THAN ONE INDIVIDUAL ASSEMBLES FOR PURPOSES OF RELIGIOUS OR
- 15 SPIRITUAL OBSERVANCE.
- 16 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT COMMIT A CRIME OF VIOLENCE, AS DEFINED IN §
- 17 14–101 OF THIS SUBTITLE, IN AN EDUCATIONAL FACILITY, A MEDICAL FACILITY, OR
- 18 A PLACE OF WORSHIP.
- 19 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND,
- 20 IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY IMPOSED FOR THE UNDERLYING CRIME OF
- 21 VIOLENCE, ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 10
- 22 YEARS.
- 23 (D) A SENTENCE IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE IMPOSED
- 24 SEPARATE FROM AND CONSECUTIVE TO OR CONCURRENT WITH A SENTENCE FOR
- 25 ANY CRIME BASED ON THE ACT ESTABLISHING THE VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2024.
