3 WHEREAS, Community health workers address the social determinants of health 4 and improve health outcomes for low-income, underrepresented, and underserved 5 communities; and

6 WHEREAS, Community health workers strive to ensure that every Marylander has 7 the opportunity to attain their highest level of health; now, therefore,

8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 9 That Section(s) 7–410 through 7–420 of Article – General Provisions of the Annotated Code 10 of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7–411 through 7–421, respectively.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read 12 as follows:

Article – General Provisions

14 **7–410.**

15 (A) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM MAY 8TH AS COMMUNITY 16 HEALTH WORKER APPRECIATION DAY.

17 **(B)** THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL 18 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKERS WITH INFORMATIVE 19 PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES.

20 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2024.
