During the open season for migratory waterfowl, a person may not fish by any means within 500 yards of any stationary blind or blind site which is occupied and is being used for hunting migratory waterfowl.

HOUSE BILL 590

1 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

2 (s) (1) "Vessel" means every description of watercraft, including an ice boat 3 but not including a seaplane, that is used or capable of being used as a means of 4 transportation on water or ice.

- (2) "Vessel" includes the motor, spars, sails, and accessories of a vessel.

DURING THE OPEN SEASON FOR MIGRATORY WATERFOWL, A PERSON MAY NOT OPERATE A VESSEL IN ANY MANNER WITHIN 500 YARDS OF ANY STATIONARY BLIND OR BLIND SITE THAT IS OCCUPIED AND BEING USED FOR HUNTING MIGRATORY WATERFOWL.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 12 1, 2024.
