BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - General Provisions Section 1–113 Annotated Code of Maryland (2019 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - General Provisions 1-113.Unless otherwise provided, in a law, resolution, or court order, judgment, or decree that refers to publishing a legal advertisement or legal notice, words such as "newspaper" or "newspaper in general circulation" mean a publication THAT IS OFFERED EITHER IN A PRINT FORMAT OR A DIGITAL FORMAT that: (1) [has at least four pages;

- comments, advertising matter, and other miscellaneous information that is of public interest and is found generally in an ordinary newspaper;
- [(3)] (2) has been published and distributed THROUGH THE PRINT OR DIGITAL FORMAT, by sale, from an established place of business at least once a week for 6 months or more before publication of the advertisement or notice;
- 6 **[**(4)**] (3)** has general circulation throughout the community where the 7 publication is published; and
- 8 [(5)] (4) IF OFFERED IN A PRINT FORMAT:
- 9 (I) HAS AT LEAST FOUR PAGES; AND
- 10 (II) qualifies for Periodicals rates for mailing through the United 11 States Postal Service.
- 12 (b) Subject to subsection (a) of this section and for purposes of the public general laws of the State, in Prince George's County, "newspaper in general circulation" includes a newspaper that:
- 15 (1) is designated by the County Council as a newspaper of record; or
- 16 (2) (i) qualifies under subsection (a) of this section with respect to 17 Prince George's County; and
- 18 (ii) is published by a small business as defined in § 14–201 of the 19 State Finance and Procurement Article.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
