11 12	WHEREAS, Vernal pools are a specialized category of nontidal wetlands that are typically water–filled from early winter through midsummer; and			
13 14 15 16	WHEREAS, Vernal pools are unique, small-scale ecosystems that contribute significantly to the biodiversity of Maryland by providing habitat for species that cannot reproduce in alternative habitats, including the wood frog, mole salamanders, and fairy shrimp; and			
17 18 19	WHEREAS, Vernal pools provide a significant amount of ecosystem services as they occur frequently throughout Maryland and have the capacity to replenish groundwater and filter stormwater flows; and			
20 21	WHEREAS, Vernal pools are threatened due to limited knowledge of their seasona presence and the lack of regulatory protections; now, therefore,
