- 3 (D) ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2025, EACH PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER 4 EDUCATION INSTITUTION SHALL POST THE POLICY ADOPTED UNDER SUBSECTION 5 (C) OF THIS SECTION ON THE INSTITUTION'S WEBSITE.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 7 1, 2024.
