1 AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City – Unpaid Water and Sewer Charges – Tax Sales of Non–Owner–Occupied Residential Property

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City to sell at tax
 sale a residential property to enforce a lien for unpaid charges for water and sewer
 service if the property is not owner-occupied; and generally relating to tax sales of
 property in Baltimore City.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Tax – Property

17 (b) (1) The collector may withhold from sale any residential property, when 18 the total taxes on the property, including interest and penalties, amount to less than \$750.

19 (2) In Baltimore City, the collector shall withhold from sale 20 owner–occupied residential property, when the total taxes on the property, including 21 interest and penalties, amount to less than \$750.

22 (3) In Baltimore City, the collector shall withhold from sale 23 **OWNER-OCCUPIED** residential property or property that is exempt from taxation under §

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1 7-204(1) or (2) of this article, if the taxes on the property consist only of a lien for unpaid 2 charges for water and sewer services.

4 (a) In Baltimore City, the Mayor and City Council may not sell a property to 5 enforce a lien for unpaid charges for water and sewer service unless:

- 6 (1) the lien is for at least \$350;
- 7 (2) the property is not:
- 8 (i) [a] OWNER-OCCUPIED residential property; or

9 (ii) real property that is exempt from taxation under § 7–204(1) or 10 (2) of this article; and

(3) the unpaid charges for water and sewer service are at least 3 quartersin arrears.

13 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, the Mayor and City Council 14 may enforce a lien on a property other than **OWNER-OCCUPIED** residential property or 15 real property that is exempt from taxation under § 7–204(1) or (2) of this article for unpaid 16 water and sewer service that is less than \$350 if the property is being sold to enforce 17 another lien.

18 (c) This section does not affect any other right or remedy of Baltimore City for the 19 collection of a water and sewer service charge.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2024.
