- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 IN THIS SUBTITLE, "AUTHORITY" MEANS THE ALLEGANY REGIONAL 2 RECREATIONAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

3 **12–1102.** 

4 THERE IS AN ALLEGANY REGIONAL RECREATIONAL ECONOMIC 5 DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY IN ALLEGANY COUNTY.

6 **12–1103.** 

7 THE AUTHORITY CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:

8 (1) THE PRESIDENT OF THE ALLEGANY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, 9 OR THE PRESIDENT'S DESIGNEE;

10 (2) THE PRESIDENT OF FROSTBURG STATE UNIVERSITY, OR THE 11 PRESIDENT'S DESIGNEE;

12 (3) THE PRESIDENT OF ALLEGANY COLLEGE, OR THE PRESIDENT'S 13 DESIGNEE;

14 (4) THE MAYOR OF CUMBERLAND, OR THE MAYOR'S DESIGNEE;

15 (5) THE MAYOR OF FROSTBURG, OR THE MAYOR'S DESIGNEE;

16 (6) THE PRESIDENT OF THE ALLEGANY COUNTY BOARD OF 17 EDUCATION, OR THE PRESIDENT'S DESIGNEE; AND

18 (7) ONE MEMBER WHO IS A RESIDENT OF ALLEGANY COUNTY 19 DESIGNATED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT REPRESENT 20 ALLEGANY COUNTY.

21 **12–1104.** 

22 (A) THE AUTHORITY MAY MANAGE APPROPRIATED FUNDS FROM 23 ALLEGANY COUNTY, THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS OF CUMBERLAND AND 24 FROSTBURG, AND THE STATE.

25 (B) THE AUTHORITY MAY RECEIVE DONATED SERVICES FROM 26 PROFESSIONALS AS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE.

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1 (C) THE AUTHORITY MAY SUPERVISE, MANAGE, AND TERMINATE STAFF 2 AND CONSULTANTS AS NECESSARY.

3 **12–1105.** 

4 **A MEMBER OF THE AUTHORITY:** 

5 (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE 6 AUTHORITY; BUT

7 (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE 8 STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

9 **12–1106.** 

10 (A) THE AUTHORITY SHALL SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT AND 11 CONSTRUCTION OF REGIONAL RECREATION FACILITIES TO BENEFIT RESIDENTS 12 AND THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF ALLEGANY COUNTY, INCLUDING:

13 (1) ATHLETIC FIELDS;

14 (2) INDOOR ATHLETIC FACILITIES; AND

15(3) OTHER FACILITIES DESIGNED TO CREATE RECREATIONAL16TOURISM.

17 (B) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 31, 2025, AND EACH OCTOBER 31 18 THEREAFTER, THE AUTHORITY SHALL REPORT ITS ACTIVITIES TO THE GOVERNOR 19 AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO 20 THE SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE, THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS 21 COMMITTEE, AND THE HOUSE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2024. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of June 30, 2029, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
