## HOUSE BILL 825

(a) There is a governing board for each regional resource center.
(b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a governit board consists of the following members:
(i) A library trustee from each participating library system; and
(ii) Up to [one member] TWO MEMBERS of the public from each ar served by the participating library systems.
(2) (i) The board of trustees of the Washington County Free Libra shall act as the governing board for the Western Maryland Regional Resource Center.
(ii) The bylaws adopted by the board of trustees of the Washingt County Free Library shall govern the composition, appointment, qualifications, terms, as structure of the governing board.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect Jul 1, $2024$ .
