- 4 FOR the purpose of altering the contents and authorized uses of the Off-Highway 5 Recreational Vehicle Trail Fund; establishing the Off-Highway Recreational Vehicle 6 Recreation Oversight Board to advise the Secretary of Natural Resources on certain 7 matters and review and approve certain expenditures; altering the percentages of 8 the revenue from a certain excise tax the Comptroller is required to distribute to the 9 Off-Highway Recreational Vehicle Trail Fund in certain fiscal years; and generally relating to the Off-Highway Recreational Vehicle Trail Fund and the Off-Highway 10 11 Recreational Vehicle Recreation Oversight Board.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (b) (3) (i) [Prior to] **BEFORE** March 31, 1976, every off—road vehicle to be used on Department lands shall be registered and provided suitable identification by the Department, which shall charge an annual uniform fee for all registrants, revenues derived from which shall be used to acquire and maintain areas for off—road vehicle use by the general public.
- 10 (ii) **1.** Any investment earnings derived from the revenues shall be credited to the [General Fund of the State] **OFF-HIGHWAY RECREATIONAL VEHICLE**12 **TRAIL FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 5–1011 OF THIS TITLE**.
- 13 Revenues from the fee are not subject to § 7–302 of the 14 State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 15 (iii) Revenues may be used for administrative costs calculated in accordance with $\S 1-103(b)(2)$ of this article.

- 18 (a) In this section, "Fund" means the Off–Highway Recreational Vehicle Trail 19 Fund.
- 20 (b) There is an Off-Highway Recreational Vehicle Trail Fund.
- 21 (c) The purpose of the Fund is to maintain and construct trails for off-highway 22 recreational vehicles.
- 23 (d) The Secretary shall administer the Fund.
- 24 (e) (1) The Fund is a special, nonlapsing fund that is not subject to § 7–302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 26 (2) The State Treasurer shall hold the Fund separately, and the 27 Comptroller shall account for the Fund.
- 28 (f) The Fund consists of:
- 29 (1) Revenue distributed to the Fund under § 13–814(b) of the 30 Transportation Article;
- 31 (2) Money appropriated in the State budget for the Fund;

- 5 (g) [The] SUBJECT TO § 5-1011.1(I) OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE Fund may be 6 used only to:
- 7 (1) Maintain trails for off-highway recreational vehicles on State park land 8 that was purchased or leased by the Department before January 1, [2017] **2024**;
- 9 (2) Maintain and construct trails for off-highway recreational vehicles on State park land that is purchased or leased by the Department on or after January 1, [2017] 11 **2024**; [and]
- 12 (3) Maintain and construct trails for off-highway recreational vehicles on 13 any land that is not State park land that is purchased or leased by the Department; **AND**
- 14 (4) MAINTAIN THE OFF-HIGHWAY RECREATIONAL VEHICLE 15 RECREATION OVERSIGHT BOARD ESTABLISHED UNDER § 5–1011.1 OF THIS 16 SUBTITLE.
- 17 (h) (1) The State Treasurer shall invest the money of the Fund in the same 18 manner as other State money may be invested.
- 19 (2) Any interest earnings of the Fund shall be credited to the General Fund 20 of the State.
- 21 (i) Expenditures from the Fund may be made only in accordance with the State 22 budget.
- 23 (j) Money expended from the Fund for maintaining and constructing trails for off-highway recreational vehicles is supplemental to and is not intended to take the place of funding that otherwise would be appropriated for maintaining and constructing trails for off-highway recreational vehicles.

- 13 (II) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND MOTORCYCLE 14 DEALERS ASSOCIATION;
- 15 (III) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE AMERICAN MOTORCYCLIST 16 ASSOCIATION DISTRICT 7;
- 17 (IV) ONE INDIVIDUAL REPRESENTING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE, 18 UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE, OR SIDE-BY-SIDE VEHICLE DRIVERS; AND
- 19 (v) One individual representing on– and off–road $20\,$ motor vehicle drivers.
- 21 (2) EACH MEMBER SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THE STATE.
- 22 (D) FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE BOARD SHALL ELECT A CHAIR EACH 23 YEAR.
- 24 (E) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 4 YEARS.
- 25 (2) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE 26 TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ON OCTOBER 1, 2024.
