3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from knowingly recruiting, harboring, 4 transporting, or obtaining an individual for the purpose of appropriating the government benefits of an individual for the benefit of the person or another by 5 6 certain means; prohibiting a person from knowingly benefitting in a certain manner 7 from participation in a venture that violates a certain provision of this Act; 8 prohibiting a person from aiding, abetting, or conspiring with one or more persons to 9 violate a certain provision of this Act; and generally relating to benefits trafficking 10 exploitation.
