- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 (b) (1) [By September 15 of the calendar year in which the qualified capital 16 expenses are paid or incurred, an] AN individual or a corporation WHO PAID OR 17 INCURRED QUALIFIED CAPITAL EXPENSES DURING THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING 18 CALENDAR YEAR may submit an application to the Department for a grant authorized 19 under this section.

20 (2) (i) For any fiscal year, the total amount of grants approved by the 21 Department under this section may not exceed the total appropriation for the Program for 22 that fiscal year.

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(ii) If the total amount of grants applied for under this section

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exceeds the maximum specified under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph, the Department
shall approve a grant for each applicant in an amount equal to the product of multiplying
the amount applied for by the applicant times a fraction:

1. the numerator of which is the maximum specified under 5 subparagraph (i) of this paragraph; and

6 2. the denominator of which is the total of all grants applied 7 for by all applicants for that calendar year.

8 (3) [On or before December 15 each year, the] **THE** Department shall 9 award the grants authorized under this section to each eligible applicant.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 11 1, 2024.

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
