- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article State Personnel and Pensions
- 14 **9–1109.**
- 15 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL EMPLOYEES, INCLUDING TEMPORARY
- 16 EMPLOYEES AND PART-TIME EMPLOYEES, OF ALL UNITS IN THE EXECUTIVE,
- 17 JUDICIAL, AND LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES OF STATE GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING ANY
- 18 UNIT WITH AN INDEPENDENT PERSONNEL SYSTEM.
- 19 (B) ON REQUEST, AN EMPLOYEE SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION MAY BE
- 20 ENTITLED TO CANCER SCREENING LEAVE WITH PAY.
- 21 (C) AN EMPLOYEE MAY:

- 1 (1) USE UP TO 4 HOURS OF CANCER SCREENING LEAVE IN ANY 2 12-MONTH PERIOD FOR CANCER SCREENING; AND
- 3 (2) USE CANCER SCREENING LEAVE ONLY AFTER OBTAINING 4 APPROVAL FROM THE EMPLOYEE'S APPOINTING AUTHORITY.
- 5 (D) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS GOVERNING CANCER SCREENING LEAVE, INCLUDING REGULATIONS THAT ESTABLISH CONDITIONS AND PROCEDURES FOR REQUESTING AND APPROVING CANCER SCREENING LEAVE.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9 1, 2024.
