2 Maryland Green Schools – Website Update and Maintenance

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Association of Environmental and Outdoor
 Education to use a certain appropriation to update, by a certain date, and maintain
 a certain website dedicated to green schools and becoming certified as a green school;
 requiring county boards of education to prominently display a link to the website on
 the county board's website and circulate certain information to teachers and staff;
 and generally relating to green schools.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE
- 19 ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$7,000 TO THE MARYLAND
- 20 ASSOCIATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL AND OUTDOOR EDUCATION TO BE USED BY THE

- 2 (2) WITHIN THE FIRST 2 WEEKS OF THE FIRST AND THIRD QUARTER
- 3 OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR, CIRCULATE INFORMATION TO TEACHERS AND STAFF ABOUT
- 4 THE GREEN SCHOOL PROGRAM AND THE WEBSITE UPDATED UNDER SUBSECTION (B)
- 5 OF THIS SECTION.
- $\,\,$ SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July $7-1,\,2024.$
