- 5 (B) "DISSOLVED AIR FLOTATION" MEANS A WASTEWATER TREATMENT 6 PROCESS THAT CLARIFIES AGRICULTURAL OR MUNICIPAL WASTEWATER BY:
- 7 (1) DISSOLVING AIR IN THE WASTEWATER THROUGH INCREASED 8 PRESSURE;
- 9 (2) RELEASING THE AIR AT ATMOSPHERIC PRESSURE IN A 10 FLOTATION TANK BASIN, CAUSING THE AIR TO ADHERE TO SUSPENDED MATTER IN 11 THE WASTEWATER AND FLOAT TO THE SURFACE; AND
