A BILL ENTITLED



- 1 (3) "RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY" MEANS PROPERTY IMPROVED BY 2 FOUR OR FEWER SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLING UNITS THAT ARE DESIGNED 3 PRINCIPALLY AND ARE INTENDED FOR HUMAN HABITATION.
- 4 (4) "TRUST MONEY" MEANS A DEPOSIT MADE BY A PURCHASER IN 5 CONNECTION WITH A RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY TRANSACTION THAT THE 6 PURCHASER DELIVERS TO AN ESCROW AGENT TO HOLD FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE 7 PURCHASER AND THE VENDOR.
- 8 (B) A VENDOR OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY MAY RESCIND A CONTRACT OF
 9 SALE FOR THE PROPERTY AT ANY TIME BEFORE THE DISTRIBUTION OF TRUST
 10 MONEY AT CLOSING IF THE PURCHASER:
- 11 (1) ASSIGNS THE CONTRACT TO ANOTHER PERSON; AND
- 12 **(2)** FAILED TO DISCLOSE IN WRITING BEFORE THE CONTRACT WAS 13 ENTERED INTO THAT THE PURCHASER MAY ASSIGN THE CONTRACT TO ANOTHER 14 PERSON.
- 15 (C) A PURCHASER OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY FROM A VENDOR THAT
 16 HOLDS AN EQUITABLE INTEREST IN THE PROPERTY OR OTHERWISE DOES NOT HOLD
 17 LEGAL TITLE TO THE PROPERTY MAY RESCIND A CONTRACT OF SALE FOR THE
 18 PROPERTY AT ANY TIME BEFORE THE DISTRIBUTION OF TRUST MONEY AT CLOSING
 19 IF THE VENDOR:
- 20 (1) ASSIGNS THE CONTRACT TO ANOTHER PERSON; AND
- 21 (2) FAILED TO DISCLOSE IN WRITING BEFORE THE CONTRACT WAS 22 ENTERED INTO THAT THE VENDOR MAY ASSIGN THE CONTRACT TO ANOTHER 23 PERSON.
- 24 (D) (1) A VENDOR OR PURCHASER OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY MAY NOT 25 BE PENALIZED FOR RESCINDING A CONTRACT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.
- 26 (2) If A VENDOR OR PURCHASER RESCINDS A CONTRACT UNDER THIS
 27 SECTION, THE ESCROWAGENT SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE TRUST MONEY TO THE PARTY
 28 THAT RESCINDED THE CONTRACT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any contracts of sale for residential property executed before the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2024.
