THE ADMINISTRATION BY AT LEAST 10 INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE:

26 27	(I) ISSUES ARISING OUT OF SPECIFIC COMPLAINTS ABOUT THE OPERATION OF THE LICENSED PREMISES; AND

- 1 (II) THE PERFORMANCE OF THE LICENSE HOLDER FOR THE 2 4-YEAR PERIOD IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE DATE OF THE RENEWAL
- 3 APPLICATION; AND
- 4 (2) MAY NOT CONSIDER ZONING ISSUES.
- 5 (D) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS 6 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2024.
