- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

 CORPS VOLUNTEER OR PEACE CORPS RESPONSE VOLUNTEER.

1 (F) (1) "RETURNED PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL 2 WHO HAS BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE PEACE CORPS AS HAVING 3 SERVED SATISFACTORILY AS A PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER.

4 (2) "RETURNED PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER" INCLUDES AN 5 INDIVIDUAL WHO SERVED AS A PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER FOR MORE THAN A YEAR 6 BEFORE DISCONTINUING SERVICE DUE TO MEDICAL HARDSHIP OR PERSONAL 7 HARDSHIP.

8 (3) "RETURNED PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER" DOES NOT INCLUDE AN 9 INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS INVOLUNTARILY DISMISSED FROM THE PEACE CORPS.

10 (G) "STATE OR LOCAL RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM" MEANS A 11 RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM OPERATED UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OR 12 A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE.

13 (H) "STATE SYSTEM" MEANS A RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM THAT IS 14 INCLUDED IN THE STATE RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEM UNDER § 21–102 OF 15 THIS ARTICLE OTHER THAN THE LEGISLATIVE PENSION PLAN EXCEPT TO THE 16 EXTENT PROVIDED BY THE JOINT RESOLUTION SUBMITTED TO THE GENERAL 17 ASSEMBLY BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY COMPENSATION COMMISSION UNDER 18 ARTICLE III, § 15 OF THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION.

DURING A PERIOD THAT A MEMBER OF A STATE OR LOCAL RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM IS ABSENT FROM EMPLOYMENT FOR PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER SERVICE, THE MEMBER OR THE MEMBER'S ESTATE, UNDER A STATE OR LOCAL RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM, IS NOT ENTITLED TO:

- 24 (1) ORDINARY DISABILITY BENEFITS;
- 25 (2) ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY BENEFITS;
- 26 (3) DEATH BENEFITS;
- 27 (4) OPTIONAL ALLOWANCES; OR
- 28 **(5)** OTHER DISABILITY OR DEATH BENEFITS.

1 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A MEMBER OF A STATE OR LOCAL 2 RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM WHO:

16 (4) APPLIES FOR SERVICE CREDIT WITH THE STATE OR LOCAL 17 RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM IN WHICH THE MEMBER HELD MEMBERSHIP 18 BEFORE THE MEMBER'S PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER SERVICE BEGAN.

(B) IF A MEMBER OF A STATE OR LOCAL RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM
WHO IS ABSENT FROM EMPLOYMENT FOR PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER SERVICE
WITHDRAWS ANY OF THE MEMBER'S ACCUMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS AND
REDEPOSITS THE SUM WITHDRAWN WITH REGULAR INTEREST INTO THE STATE OR
LOCAL RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM, THE MEMBER, IF OTHERWISE QUALIFIED,
IS ENTITLED TO THE BENEFITS UNDER THIS SECTION AS IF THE WITHDRAWAL HAD
NOT BEEN MADE.

(C) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, A MEMBER OF A
STATE OR LOCAL RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM WHO IS ACTIVELY
REEMPLOYED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(2) OF THIS SECTION RETAINS THE STATUS
AND RIGHTS AS A MEMBER DURING A PERIOD OF ABSENCE FROM EMPLOYMENT FOR
PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER SERVICE.

(D) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A MEMBER OF
 A STATE OR LOCAL RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM SHALL RECEIVE SERVICE
 CREDIT FOR A PERIOD OF ABSENCE FROM EMPLOYMENT WHILE IN PEACE CORPS
 VOLUNTEER SERVICE IF:

13 (F) THE SERVICE CREDIT FOR PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER SERVICE THAT A 14 MEMBER OF A STATE SYSTEM RECEIVES UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE APPLIED 15 TO THE INDIVIDUAL'S RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE USING THE ACCRUAL RATE AT THE 16 TIME THE INDIVIDUAL RETIRES FROM A STATE SYSTEM.

(I) A MEMBER OF A STATE SYSTEM; OR

20 (II) A FORMER MEMBER OF A STATE SYSTEM WHO IS ELIGIBLE 21 TO RECEIVE A BENEFIT UNDER § 29–302 OR § 29–303 OF THIS ARTICLE.

22 (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A RETIREE OF A STATE 23 SYSTEM.

(B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION WHO HAS NOT MET THE CONDITIONS SET FORTH IN § 38–303(A)(2) THROUGH (4) OF THIS SUBTITLE IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE SERVICE CREDIT FOR PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER SERVICE ONLY ON THE ATTAINMENT OF 10 YEARS OF SERVICE CREDIT EARNED THROUGH EMPLOYMENT AS A MEMBER OF A STATE SYSTEM.

30 (C) (1) AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 31 MAY NOT RECEIVE CREDIT FOR THAT PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER SERVICE IF THE INDIVIDUAL RECEIVES CREDIT FOR PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEER SERVICE FROM
 ANOTHER RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR WHICH RETIREMENT BENEFITS HAVE BEEN OR
 WILL BE RECEIVED BY THE INDIVIDUAL.
