- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a person who undertakes the towing or removal of a vehicle 4 from a parking lot to notify the insurer of record electronically if that form of notice 5 is agreed to by the tower and the insurer of record in a certain manner; and generally relating to notification of the insurer of record after towing or removing a vehicle 6 7 from a parking lot.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 13
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Transportation**

- 21-10A-04. 16
- 17 Unless otherwise set by local law, a person who undertakes the towing or 18 removal of a vehicle from a parking lot:
- 19 (3)Shall notify the owner, the insurer of record, and, except as 20 provided in item (ii) of this item, THE INSURER OF RECORD AND any secured party by 21 certified mail, return receipt requested, and first-class mail within 7 days, exclusive of days
- 22that the towing business is closed, after towing or removing the vehicle, and shall provide



- the same information required in a notice to a police department under item (2) of this subsection; and
- 3 (ii) May provide notice required under item (i) of this item to any 4 secured party **OR INSURER OF RECORD** electronically, if that form of notice is agreed to 5 by the tower and the secured party **OR INSURER OF RECORD** in writing or by electronic communication;
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2024.
