SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

(b) (1) $\mathbf{2}$ COMMONLY KNOWN AS **PATUXENT FISH** CHESAPEAKE CHANNA, in the tidal waters of 3 the State using: 4 (i) A bow and arrow attached to a retrieval line; or $\mathbf{5}$ (ii) Hook and line. 6 (2)A licensee may not fish with a bow and arrow under the license within 7 100 yards of: 8 (i) Another person or vessel; 9 (ii) A public or private swimming area; 10 (iii) A diver down flag; or An occupied offshore stationary blind. 11 (iv) 12An applicant for a license does not need to hold a tidal fish license under § (c) 134–701 of this subtitle to be eligible for the license. 14A person who wishes to obtain a license shall complete and submit an (d) 15application for the license to the Department or any person designated by the Department. 16 The term of the license is 1 year from September 1 through August 31 of the (e) 17following year. 18 (f) The annual license fee is \$15.
