FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Social Work Examiners in accordance with the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act by extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the Board; <u>requiring the Board to report certain information relating to</u> <u>the issuance of licenses and the resolution of complaints to certain committees of the</u> <u>General Assembly</u>; and generally relating to the State Board of Social Work

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28July 1, 2024.

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
