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- 1 (3) "PARTICIPANT" MEANS AN ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUAL WHOM THE 2 DEPARTMENT APPROVES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PA2E PROGRAM.
- 3 (4) "PA2E PROGRAM" MEANS THE PUBLIC ASSISTANCE TO 4 ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROGRAM.
- 5 (B) (1) THERE IS A PUBLIC ASSISTANCE TO ENTREPRENEURSHIP 6 (PA2E) PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT.
- 7 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE PA2E PROGRAM IS TO TRAIN 8 PARTICIPANTS ON HOW TO ESTABLISH AND RUN A SMALL BUSINESS.
- 9 (3) THE PA2E PROGRAM SHALL:
- 10 (I) INTRODUCE PARTICIPANTS TO THE VALUES AND BASICS OF 11 STARTING AND RUNNING A BUSINESS; AND

- 4 (II) NOTIFY EACH APPLICANT OF THE DEPARTMENT'S DECISION 5 TO APPROVE OR DENY AN APPLICATION FOR BUSINESS START-UP FUNDING WITHIN 6 **60** DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF THE APPLICATION.
- 7 (E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A PROCESS FOR EVALUATING THE 8 EFFECTIVENESS OF THE PA2E PROGRAM IN ADDRESSING POVERTY FOR ELIGIBLE 9 INDIVIDUALS AND THEIR HOUSEHOLDS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2024.
