# SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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#### Article – State Government

- 14 It is unlawful for any notary public to sign and issue any protest except in the form 15 prescribed by the Comptroller.]
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2024.
