Health Occupations - Clinical Marriage and Family Therapists - Reciprocal Licensure Requirements

FOR the purpose of altering the licensure requirements that the State Board of Professional
Counselors and Therapists may waive, and the circumstances under which the
requirements may be waived, for applicants for a license to practice clinical marriage
and family therapy in the State who are licensed or certified to practice clinical
marriage and family therapy in another state, territory, or jurisdiction; and
