4 FOR the purpose of altering requirements for procedures relating to electric vehicle 5 recharging equipment in a condominium or homeowners association to include 6 equipment for electric bicycles; establishing certain requirements and procedures 7 relating to an application to the governing body of a cooperative housing corporation 8 to install or use electric vehicle recharging equipment; requiring the Department of 9 Housing and Community Development to provide certain information on its common ownership community website; and generally relating to electric vehicle recharging 10 11 equipment in common ownership communities.
