## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## State Department of Education - School Psychologist Recruitment Program

- FOR the purpose of establishing the School Psychologist Recruitment Program within the State Department of Education; requiring the Program to provide professional
- 5 development programs and aid for a certain certification fee to school psychologists
- and individuals seeking to become school psychologists and to reimburse school
- 7 psychologists for professional conference expenses; and generally relating to the
- 8 School Psychologist Recruitment Program.
- 9 BY adding to
- 10 Article Education
- 11 Section 6–129
- 12 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 13 (2022 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement)
- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Education
- 17 **6–129.**
- 18 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 19 INDICATED.
- 20 (2) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST RECRUITMENT
- 21 PROGRAM.
- 22 (3) "SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS
- 23 CERTIFIED TO PROVIDE PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES TO CHILDREN IN A PUBLIC

- 1 SCHOOL OR A STATE-APPROVED NONPUBLIC SCHOOL SETTING IN THE STATE.
- 2 (B) (1) THERE IS A SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST RECRUITMENT PROGRAM 3 WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT.
- 4 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL
- 5 SUPPORT TO SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS IN THE STATE AND INDIVIDUALS SEEKING TO
- 6 BECOME SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS IN THE STATE.
- 7 (C) (1) THE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT
- 8 PROGRAMS TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE, OR ARE SEEKING TO BECOME, SCHOOL
- 9 PSYCHOLOGISTS.
- 10 (2) PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT MAY INCLUDE:
- 11 (I) VIRTUAL COURSES OR WEBINARS;
- 12 (II) MENTORING OR PEER COLLABORATION PROGRAMS; AND
- 13 (III) THE PROVISION OF SUPPORT MATERIALS.
- 14 (3) IN PROVIDING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT TO SCHOOL
- 15 PSYCHOLOGISTS, THE PROGRAM SHALL:
- 16 (I) MAINTAIN A CLEARINGHOUSE OF SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST
- 17 BEST PRACTICES TO SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT OF SCHOOL
- 18 PSYCHOLOGISTS;
- 19 (II) COMMUNICATE AND PROMOTE UPCOMING OPPORTUNITIES
- 20 AND AVAILABLE RESOURCES TO SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS; AND
- 21 (III) SEEK TO PROVIDE SUPPORT TO SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS
- 22 FROM GROUPS HISTORICALLY UNDERREPRESENTED AMONG PROFESSIONAL
- 23 PERSONNEL IN THE STATE.
- 24 (D) (1) THE PROGRAM SHALL REIMBURSE SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS FOR
- 25 ATTENDING PROFESSIONAL CONFERENCES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS
- 26 SUBSECTION.

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- 27 (2) A SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST SHALL SUBMIT TO THE PROGRAM AN
- 28 APPLICATION FOR REIMBURSEMENT ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE PROGRAM THAT
- 29 INCLUDES THE SUBMISSION OF:
  - (I) MATERIALS ON THE PROFESSIONAL CONFERENCE AND AN

- 1 EXPLANATION OF ITS RELEVANCE TO THE SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST'S PROFESSION;
- 2 **AND**
- 3 (II) RECEIPTS OR OTHER DOCUMENTATION OF THE EXPENSES
- 4 FOR WHICH THE SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST REQUESTS TO BE REIMBURSED.
- 5 (3) SUBJECT TO FUNDING AVAILABILITY, THE PROGRAM SHALL
- 6 APPROVE AN APPLICANT TO RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION
- 7 IF:
- 8 (I) THE APPLICATION IS COMPLETE AND IS RECEIVED NOT
- 9 LATER THAN 180 DAYS AFTER THE LAST DAY OF THE CONFERENCE;
- 10 (II) THE AMOUNT REQUESTED DOES NOT EXCEED AN AMOUNT
- 11 DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT BY REGULATION; AND
- 12 (III) THE APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A
- 13 REIMBURSEMENT.
- 14 (E) (1) (I) SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH,
- 15 EACH YEAR, THE PROGRAM SHALL SELECT, CONSISTENT WITH THE AMOUNT
- 16 PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE PROGRAM, A MAXIMUM OF 100
- 17 INDIVIDUALS FOR WHOM THE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE FUNDS TO PAY THE
- 18 CERTIFICATION FEE CHARGED BY THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL
- 19 PSYCHOLOGISTS.
- 20 (II) IN SELECTING INDIVIDUALS UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH, THE
- 21 PROGRAM SHALL GIVE PRIORITY TO SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS FROM GROUPS
- 22 HISTORICALLY UNDERREPRESENTED AMONG PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL IN THE
- 23 **STATE.**
- 24 (2) (I) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO DOES NOT COMPLETE ALL THE
- 25 REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION BY THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL
- 26 PSYCHOLOGISTS SHALL REIMBURSE THE PROGRAM THE FULL AMOUNT OF THE AID
- 27 RECEIVED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 28 (II) THE PROVISIONS OF SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS
- 29 PARAGRAPH DO NOT APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO COMPLETES ALL THE
- 30 REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION BY THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL
- 31 PSYCHOLOGISTS BUT WHO DOES NOT RECEIVE CERTIFICATION.
- 32 (3) THE PROGRAM MAY PROVIDE AID TO AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THIS
- 33 SUBSECTION FOR UP TO TWO APPLICATIONS FOR CERTIFICATION BY THE NATIONAL
- 34 ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS.

- 1 **(F)** THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 2 SECTION, INCLUDING:
- 3 (1) THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT THE PROGRAM MAY REIMBURSE UNDER 4 SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION;
- 5 (2) PROCEDURES FOR AN INDIVIDUAL TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION 6 TO THE PROGRAM; AND
- 7 (3) CRITERIA FOR THE SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS OF AID UNDER 8 THE PROGRAM.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 10 1, 2024.
