18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis

- This title applies only in Caroline County.

- 1 There is a 1-day beer [and], wine, AND LIQUOR tasting [(BWT)] (BWLT) (a) 2 license. 3 The Board may issue the license to a holder of a [current] license or an (b) organization that qualifies for a [Class C beer or Class C beer and wine license under § 4 5 4-1203 of this article] CLASS C PER DIEM BEER, A CLASS C PER DIEM BEER AND WINE, 6 OR A CLASS C PER DIEM BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE. 7 (c) (1) The license authorizes the holder to allow the consumption of beer [or]. 8 wine, OR LIQUOR for tasting if: 9 the consumer is not charged for the beer [or], wine, OR LIQUOR; (i) 10 and 11 (ii) the beer [or], wine, OR LIQUOR is consumed on the licensed 12 premises. 13 The license may not be issued to a person more than 26 times in a (2) calendar year. 14 (d) The Board need not publish a license application before granting the license. 15 16 An individual may consume beer [or], wine, OR LIQUOR covered by the 17 license in a quantity of not more than:
- 18 (1) 3 ounces from each offering of beer, and [8] 9 ounces from all offerings 19 in a day; [and]
- 20 (2) 1 ounce from each offering of wine, and 4 ounces from all offerings in a 21 day; AND
- 22 (3) 0.5 OUNCE FROM EACH OFFERING OF LIQUOR, AND 2.5 OUNCES 23 FROM ALL OFFERINGS IN A DAY.
- 24 (f) At the end of the day for which the license is valid, the license holder shall 25 dispose of beer [or], wine, OR LIQUOR that remains in a container that was opened for 26 tasting.
- 27 (g) The license fee is \$50.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
