- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 **15–811.1.**
- 16 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:
- 17 (1) INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT
- 18 PROVIDE LABOR AND DELIVERY COVERAGE TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS ON AN
- 19 EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS UNDER HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES OR CONTRACTS
- 20 THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND
- 21 (2) HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE LABOR
- 22 AND DELIVERY COVERAGE TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS UNDER CONTRACTS THAT
- 23 ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.

- 1 (B) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL COVER LABOR AND DELIVERY SERVICES WITHOUT A DEDUCTIBLE, COINSURANCE, COPAYMENT, OR ANY OTHER COST—SHARING REQUIREMENT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all policies, contracts, and health benefit plans issued, delivered, or renewed in the State on or after January 1, 2025.
- 7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 January 1, 2025.
