15 16	(a) (1) Each county board may use volunteer aides in school activities in its county.
17 18	(2) A COUNTY BOARD MAY USE A CHAPLAIN AS A VOLUNTEER AIDE IN SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE SUPPORT SERVICES TO STUDENTS.
19 20	(b) A volunteer aide may not be used to supplant educational personnel but shall be used to assist regular employees in their assignments.
21	(c) Each county superintendent shall establish guidelines for the use of volunteer

aides in the school system of the superintendent's county.
