13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
15	Article - Tax - Property
16	14–811.
17 18	(b) (1) The collector may withhold from sale any residential property, when the total taxes on the property, including interest and penalties, amount to less than \$750.
19 20 21	(2) In Baltimore City, the collector shall withhold from sale owner–occupied residential property, when the total taxes on the property, including interest and penalties, amount to less than \$750.
22 23	(3) In Baltimore City, the collector shall withhold from sale OWNER-OCCUPIED residential property or property that is exempt from taxation under §



- 7-204(1) or (2) of this article, if the taxes on the property consist only of a lien for unpaid charges for water and sewer services.

- 4 (a) In Baltimore City, the Mayor and City Council may not sell a property to enforce a lien for unpaid charges for water and sewer service unless:
- 6 (1) the lien is for at least \$350;
- 7 (2) the property is not:
- 8 (i) [a] OWNER-OCCUPIED residential property; or
- 9 (ii) real property that is exempt from taxation under $\S 7-204(1)$ or 10 (2) of this article; and
- 11 (3) the unpaid charges for water and sewer service are at least 3 quarters 12 in arrears.
- 13 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, the Mayor and City Council
 14 may enforce a lien on a property other than **OWNER-OCCUPIED** residential property or
 15 real property that is exempt from taxation under § 7–204(1) or (2) of this article for unpaid
 16 water and sewer service that is less than \$350 if the property is being sold to enforce
 17 another lien.
- 18 (c) This section does not affect any other right or remedy of Baltimore City for the collection of a water and sewer service charge.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
