- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Education
- 16 15-106.8.

17 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, an individual shall be 18 exempt from paying the out-of-state tuition rate at a public institution of higher education 19 in the State, and shall be eligible for the tuition rates described under subsections (c) and 20 (d) of this section, if the individual:

(4) Provides to the public institution of higher education documentation
that the individual or the individual's parent or legal guardian has filed a Maryland income
tax return [annually] for the [3-year period] TAXABLE YEAR IMMEDIATELY before the
academic year in which the tuition rate exemption would apply;

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 2 1, 2024.
