FOR the purpose of altering a signage requirement for retail service stations relating to the price of regular gasoline; altering a signage authorization for retail service stations relating to the price of diesel and other motor fuel products; repealing an exemption from a certain signage requirement for retail service station dealers with not more than a certain number of dispensing units and nozzles; and generally relating to pricing signs at retail service stations.
