BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Public Safety Section 13–411 Annotated Code of Maryland (2022 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Public Safety 13-411. In this section, "eligible recipient" means an individual who is: (a) (1) eligible for Tricare Reserve Select coverage; and
