- (II) **OSSEO-INTEGRATED DEVICE SURGERY;**
- 8 (III) COCHLEAR IMPLANT SURGERY; OR

9 (IV) THE PREPARATION, OPERATION, OR PERFORMANCE OF 10 RADIOGRAPHIC IMAGING.

#### 11 (R-1) "SOUND PROCESSOR" MEANS A NONSURGICAL, EXTERNAL UNIT THAT 12 ATTACHES TO AN INTERNAL OSSEO–INTEGRATED DEVICE OR COCHLEAR IMPLANT.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 October 1, 2024.
