## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Legal Advertisement or Legal Notice – Publication in Newspaper or Newspaper
in General Circulation – Digital Newspapers

FOR the purpose of altering the meaning of "newspaper" or "newspaper in general circulation" when referring to the publication of a certain legal advertisement or legal notice to include certain publications that are offered in a print format or a digital format under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the publication of legal advertisements and legal notices.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article General Provisions
- 17 1–113.
- 18 (a) Unless otherwise provided, in a law, resolution, or court order, judgment, or 19 decree that refers to publishing a legal advertisement or legal notice, words such as
- 20 "newspaper" or "newspaper in general circulation" mean a publication THAT IS OFFERED
- 21 EITHER IN A PRINT FORMAT OR A DIGITAL FORMAT that:
- (1) [has at least four pages;
- 23 (2)] habitually contains news items, reports of current events, editorial



- comments, advertising matter, and other miscellaneous information that is of public interest and is found generally in an ordinary newspaper;
- [(3)] (2) has been published and distributed THROUGH THE PRINT OR DIGITAL FORMAT, by sale, from an established place of business at least once a week for 6 months or more before publication of the advertisement or notice;
- 6 **[**(4)**] (3)** has general circulation throughout the community where the 7 publication is published; and
- 8 [(5)] (4) IF OFFERED IN A PRINT FORMAT:
- 9 (I) HAS AT LEAST FOUR PAGES; AND
- 10 (II) qualifies for Periodicals rates for mailing through the United 11 States Postal Service.
- 12 (b) Subject to subsection (a) of this section and for purposes of the public general laws of the State, in Prince George's County, "newspaper in general circulation" includes a newspaper that:
- 15 (1) is designated by the County Council as a newspaper of record; or
- 16 (2) (i) qualifies under subsection (a) of this section with respect to 17 Prince George's County; and
- 18 (ii) is published by a small business as defined in § 14–201 of the 19 State Finance and Procurement Article.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
