State and Local Parks – Playgrounds – Safety Standards (Our Kids Play Safe Playground Safety Act of 2024)

FOR the purpose of requiring each unit of State or local government responsible for the construction and maintenance of a playground to ensure that the playground is constructed and maintained in accordance with certain safety standards; requiring a unit of State or local government to inspect a certain playground to evaluate compliance with certain safety standards and to keep an inspection record in a certain manner; and generally relating to safety standards for playgrounds.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 (A) EACH UNIT OF STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE 2 CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A PLAYGROUND SHALL ENSURE THAT THE 3 PLAYGROUND IS CONSTRUCTED AND MAINTAINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MOST 4 RECENT PUBLICATION OF:

5 (1) THE PUBLIC PLAYGROUND SAFETY HANDBOOK, PUBLISHED BY 6 THE U.S. CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY COMMISSION;

7 (2) THE STANDARD CONSUMER SAFETY PERFORMANCE
8 SPECIFICATION FOR PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT FOR PUBLIC USE, PUBLISHED BY
9 THE AMERICAN NATIONAL STANDARDS INSTITUTE; AND

10 (3) THE STANDARD SPECIFICATION FOR IMPACT ATTENUATION OF 11 SURFACING MATERIALS WITHIN THE USE ZONE OF PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT, 12 PUBLISHED BY THE AMERICAN NATIONAL STANDARDS INSTITUTE.

13 (B) AT LEAST ONCE EVERY 2 YEARS, EACH UNIT OF STATE OR LOCAL 14 GOVERNMENT RESPONSIBLE FOR A PLAYGROUND SHALL INSPECT THE 15 PLAYGROUND TO EVALUATE COMPLIANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

16 (C) AFTER COMPLETION OF EACH INSPECTION CONDUCTED IN 17 ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A UNIT OF STATE OR LOCAL 18 GOVERNMENT SHALL KEEP AN INSPECTION RECORD, INCLUDING A WRITTEN PLAN 19 TO ADDRESS ANY SAFETY HAZARDS DISCOVERED DURING THE INSPECTION.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2024.
