- 1 (B) (1) IF A PERSON FAILS TO OBEY A SUBPOENA SERVED BY THE ANNE 2 ARUNDEL COUNTY HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION:
- 3 (1) THE INDIVIDUAL AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE OF THE SUBPOENA
  4 MAY AUTHORIZE THE INDIVIDUAL SERVING THE SUBPOENA TO CERTIFY THE
- 5 DEFAULT TO THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT; AND
- 6 (2) ON CERTIFICATION OF THE DEFAULT, THE CLERK SHALL ISSUE A
  7 BODY ATTACHMENT TO THE SHERIFF AGAINST THE PERSON NAMED IN THE
  8 SUBPOENA, RETURNABLE ON THE DATE SPECIFIED IN THE ATTACHMENT, TO

  27 SHALL BE SERVED ON THE PERSON TO WHOM IT IS DIRECTED BY THE SHERIFF OR
  28 DEPUTY SHERIFF.
- 29 (3) A FAILURE TO OBEY AN ORDER ISSUED BY THE COURT UNDER 30 THIS SUBSECTION MAY BE PUNISHED BY THE COURT AS CONTEMPT OF COURT.
- 31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 32 October 1, 2024.
