A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Artificial Intelligence Advisory and Oversight Commission**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Artificial Intelligence Advisory and
4 Oversight Commission to guide the State in growing, developing, using, and
5 diversifying artificial intelligence; and generally relating to the Maryland Artificial
6 Intelligence Advisory and Oversight Commission.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

15 **3.5–205.**

16 **(A) THERE IS A MARYLAND ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE ADVISORY AND**
17 **OVERSIGHT COMMISSION.**

18 **(B) THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:**

19 **(1) TWO MEMBERS OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, APPOINTED BY**
20 **THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;**

21 **(2) TWO MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY**
22 **THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(3) FIVE MEMBERS OF THE PRIVATE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE**
2 **SECTOR, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR; AND**

3 **(4) A MEMBER OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, APPOINTED BY**
4 **THE CHAIR OF THE STATE BOARD.**

5 **(C) THE GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE THE CHAIR OF THE COMMISSION.**

6 **(D) THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SHALL PROVIDE**
7 **STAFF FOR THE COMMISSION.**

8 **(E) A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION:**

9 **(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE**
10 **COMMISSION; BUT**

11 **(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE**
12 **STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.**

13 **(F) THE COMMISSION SHALL:**

14 **(1) GUIDE THE STATE IN GROWING, DEVELOPING, USING, AND**
15 **DIVERSIFYING ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE IN THE STATE;**

16 **(2) ENSURE THAT THERE IS DIVERSITY IN CONTRACT AWARDS AND**
17 **TRAINING PROGRAMS RELATED TO ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE IN THE STATE,**
18 **INCLUDING RACIAL DIVERSITY; AND**

19 **(3) ASSIST AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE USE OF**
20 **ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE BY DIVERSE GROUPS IN THE STATE.**

21 **(G) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2024, AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE**
22 **COMMISSION SHALL REPORT ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE**
23 **GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT**
24 **ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.**

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
26 1, 2024. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and 1 month and, at the end of June
27 30, 2027, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be
28 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
