A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County – Out-of-State Vehicles – Improper Registration**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing Baltimore County to tow, remove, or impound a vehicle
4 owned by a new resident of the State who fails to register the vehicle with the Motor
5 Vehicle Administration and display valid registration plates issued by the
6 Administration within a certain time period; and generally relating to towing,
7 removal, and impounding of improperly registered out-of-state vehicles in
8 Baltimore County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Transportation**

22 13–402.

23 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section or elsewhere in the
24 Maryland Vehicle Law, each motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, and pole trailer driven on
25 a highway shall be registered under this subtitle.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (2) If a motor vehicle required to be registered under this subtitle is not
2 registered, a person may not park the unregistered motor vehicle on any:

3 (i) Public alley, street, or highway; or

4 (ii) Private property used by the public in general, including parking
5 lots of shopping centers, condominiums, apartments, or town house developments.

6 (3) The provisions of paragraph (2) of this subsection do not apply to a
7 motor vehicle that is exempt from registration under this section or § 13–402.1 of this
8 subtitle.

9 (c) Registration under this subtitle is not required for:

10 (7) A vehicle owned by a new resident of this State during the first 60 days
11 of residency provided the vehicle displays valid registration issued by the jurisdiction of the
12 resident's former domicile;

13 26–301.

14 (b) Subject to subsection (c) of this section, any State agency authorized by law
15 and any political subdivision of this State may adopt ordinances or regulations that:

16 (1) Regulate the parking of vehicles;

17 (2) Provide for the impounding of vehicles parked in violation of the
18 ordinances or regulations;

19 (3) Regulate the towing of vehicles from publicly owned and privately
20 owned parking lots; and

21 (4) Provide for the issuance of a citation by an officer for a violation of an
22 ordinance or regulation that is adopted under this section.

23 **(B–1) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE COUNTY.**

24 **(2) BALTIMORE COUNTY MAY TOW, REMOVE, OR IMPOUND A VEHICLE**
25 **OWNED BY A NEW RESIDENT OF THE STATE WHO FAILS TO REGISTER THE VEHICLE**
26 **WITH THE ADMINISTRATION AND DISPLAY VALID REGISTRATION PLATES ISSUED BY**
27 **THE ADMINISTRATION WITHIN 60 DAYS AS REQUIRED UNDER § 13–402 OF THIS**
28 **ARTICLE.**

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
30 October 1, 2024.
