10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

The Black Male Yoga Initiative (BMYI) is a non-profit organization dedicated to promoting physical and mental well-being among black men through yoga and mindfulness practices. Its mission is to address the unique challenges faced by black men in society, including stress, health disparities, and limited access to wellness resources. BMYI aims to create a supportive community where individuals can learn yoga, engage in holistic self-care, and foster personal growth. The initiative also seeks to challenge stereotypes about who can practice yoga, promoting inclusivity and diversity within the yoga community. BMYI empowers black men to improve their health, reduce stress, and cultivate a balanced lifestyle through classes, workshops, and community outreach. Past programs include youth offenders, DSS, DJS, and public schools.

The Welcome Center will be next to the current Yoga Studio. The Welcome Center will serve as a multifunctional area for the yoga studio. The Welcome Center will have two bathrooms, a conference room, a small office, and a welcome desk. It will be disabled-body accessible. The Center will have an open layout, with a new septic tank and a water well for fresh water. The electric main from the yoga studio will power a two-ton split HVAC unit at the new Welcome Center. Landscaping upgrades will enhance the property. Finally, an attached 28' x 14' greenhouse on the side of the center will focus on herbal agriculture and sustainable farming, using solar panels.
