10. Description and Purpose of Organiza	tion (Limit lengt	h to visible area)			

The Calverton School is a non-profit, PreK-12 independent school located in Calvert County and was founded in 1967. Calverton has grown over the decades to a vibrant, inclusive, and diverse PreK-12 day and boarding school. Calverton continuously works to upgrade, renovate and repair its facilities for faculty, students, and the community. The Calverton School's student body has increased this year by 16 percent with a diverse student population representing five surrounding counties and shares its athletic facilities with over a dozen local youth organizations. In 2021-22, Calverton served over 320 students. More than 50 percent of the students attending Calverton received awards of more than \$1M in financial assistance each year.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The Calverton School is seeking a grant of \$270,000 to upgrade its current Wifi network infrastructure to Wifi 6. This upgrade will replace the current 72 Wireless Access Points with advanced Wifi 6 technology. Wifi 6 technology uses OFDMA (Orthogonal Frequency Division Multiple Access) which allows for more efficient data transmission, enabling multiple students to connect simultaneously without bandwidth congestion. This is crucial in a learning environment where multiple devices are used at once. Wifi 6's improved battery life optimization ensures longer usage for student devices, which is essential for uninterrupted learning during the school day. Wifi 6 also provides stronger, more reliable signals with its improved MU-MIMO (Multi-User, Multiple Input, Multiple Output) capabilities, ensuring that even remote areas of the campus, including outdoor sports fields, have consistent and strong internet coverage.
