10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					

The Caring Cupboard is a 501c3 organization that is dedicated to the elimination of food insecurity among the residents of Anne Arundel County. We provide services through a "store" located at 8513 Fort Smallwood Road in Pasadena; Little Free Pantries (akin to little free libraries but with food,) through a partnership with the AA Co. Library System and several churches in AA Co.; and through a partnership with the University of Maryland Medical Systems and our Mobile Food Pantry, a converted school bus. Additionally, we also have in-school pantries in several AACPS schools.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The Cupboard is located in a building that is approximately 1,700 square feet. Due to a very leaky roof, only half of that space is available for use by the community. Funding for this project would allow the Cupboard to replace the roof and afford us the opportunity to remodel the other half of our facility and expand services to the community.
