28. Comments

The Coldspring community center, also known as the Mercantile Building, was an integral part of the Coldspring Newtown development. Unfortunately, despite its initial promise, the center has faced challenges over the years. For the past five years, it has sat vacant and decaying, affecting property values and insurance costs in the neighborhood. Efforts to revitalize the property have not been successful so far.
