It is .42 sq. mi., offering full services of police, public works, and general government to our residents. The Town is committed to providing all the necessary services at the highest level to our residents, businesses and visitors ensuring a premium quality of life is maintained, providing a safe and clean environment for all persons, and planning with the support and cooperation of our community. The Town of Edmonston is committed to reducing our green house emissions by creating a well lit network of walkable sidewalks and trails that residents can use to commute to work and play, as well as connect to area retail shopping and entertainment. This project is consistent with the Town's committment to being environmentally conscious by using LED Street lights that match existing lights on our "green" main street. The LED lights will reduce light pollution, improve visibility, lower energy costs, and decrease maintenance.
