28. Comments

The 9.68 Acreas of Land was purchased on April 21, 2017 for \$40,000 plus another \$10,000 in Legal Fees. The Title is free of any encumbrances. jThere is around 7 Acreas of open field and 3 Acreas of wooden land at the back of the property.

Our Current Income is in the form of Active Membership Dues for a Total of \$52,000 per year. This doesn't include other donations or Associate Membership Dues. Expenses, including Real Estate Taxes, Dues to State and National FOP, Membership Legal Plan and the Operational Expenses of the Lodge comes to \$24,000 a year. This leaves around \$26,000 a year to run the Lodge on. The Lodge currently has around \$52,000 in Operational Funds at this time. We also have around \$5,000 in Funds to aid officers who are hurt or killed in the Line of Duty.

It is our hope to someday also build a Firearms Training Area on the back 3 Acreas of wooden area to be used by our Members and to also allow our local departments of Cambridge Police, the Dorchester County Sheriff's Office, the Hurlock Police and even the Maryland State Police if they so desire. This Firearms Range will be free of charge other than any required mantenance that may be needed by the use of those agencies. This is of course another project for a later date.

Our Membership has been working toward this project for over 20 years and it is our intent to move forward at this time with the project no matter what, even if it means not fully completing it and having to somehow raise more funds through the help of our local community citizens and businesses and/or return to the State again for its aid.
