28. Comments

Straddling Montgomery and Prince Georges Counties, Fairland Recreational Park is part of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission. Of the 322 acres on Montgomery County side, only 39 acres are developed with athletic fields and courts. The remaining parkland is preserved in its natural state. On the Prince Georges County side, the park is home to the Fairland Sports and Aquatic Complex.

Fairland Rec Park is a well-used facility that provides a variety of amenities for the community, and Montgomery Parks is always looking to modernize our amenities to meet the emerging trends and demands of the community. We have received strong support for skateparks throughout the park system, and particularly in the eastern portion of the County. Creating a skatepark with the associated improvements to support it at this facility would be a great step in meeting the current community needs.

Our current budget does not allow us to create new amenities such as these as quickly as they are needed, and this project would greatly enhance the value of this park to the community it serves. With financial assistance from the State, this community will receive a great new amenity that it deserves.
