10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)						

As the sole provider of behavioral health and rape crisis services across the five counties of the Mid-Shore, representing over 22% of the states geography, For All Seasons plays a vital role in safeguarding the well-being of Marylanders. Last year, the agency delivered over 50,000 essential therapy, psychiatry, and sexual assault victim support sessions to 3,000 individuals and families from the entire state, with seven offices on the Eastern Shore and through telehealth. For All Seasons is distinguished as a national Rural Innovation Site by the Rural Justice Collaborative. The agency provides no-waitlist mental health services through its Open Access program, which offers same-day treatment for new clients establishing care.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

For All Seasons, Inc. is a nonprofit outpatient behavioral health provider and rape crisis center serving thousands of residents of the rural Eastern Shore and throughout all 24 Maryland jurisdictions through telehealth. Requested funding supports the retrofit, renovation, and upgrade of the agency's existing headquarters in Easton, MD to provide more and better access to community-based behavioral health and victim support services. Grant funds will support pre-construction and construction costs for this expanded mental health facility serving low-income, rural Marylanders. This project has already been cleared by the Maryland State Clearinghouse (State Application Identifier: MD20230203-0089) and is a priority Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) project approved by the Mid-Shore Regional Council.
