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#### **10. Description and Purpose of Organization** (Limit length to visible area)

Genesee Valley is an independent not-for-profit experiential education facility specializing in ethical character development and social emotional learning. We utilize our extensive challenge course as an educational tool rather than simply a pay for play experience. Our nonprofit has been providing valuable outdoor and experiential education opportunities in the Baltimore community for decades. During its 42 years of operation, GVOLC has served over 1,000,000 participants from the surrounding region. Schools, corporate businesses, and various non-profit organizations from all across the state have chosen GVOLC as their destination. Participants grow by engaging in team building and character development programs that encourage individuals to take on leadership roles, develop communication skills, foster trust in their peers and step outside their comfort zone.

### 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

While GVOLC has access to outdoor spaces, it lacks a modern, multipurpose indoor facility to accommodate the diverse groups that we serve and better meet their needs. The Welcome Center will provide a new office space for GVOLC as well as private rooms to facilitate adventure therapy sessions. This new building will allow us to serve more participants each year and raise the participant cap for our summer camp. Most importantly, it will provide a space for various outside community groups to meet closer to home. There are few places in the Hereford Zone for community groups to meet, plan their programs or use as a base of operations. This new building not only supports GVOLC in their programs, but will serve as an easily accessible space that can serve the local population for decades to come.
