Through shared experiences, and mutual trust, the relationship between humans and horses serves as a source of profound enrichment in both individuals' lives. These experiences will happen through equine facilitated learning programs, educational clinics, retreats. The center may also serve as a unique meeting space for businesses and the community. Our goal is to provide low to no cost options for participants from the Fire and Police Departments, Paramedics, Front-Line Workers, Women's Shelters, as well as caretakers for the elderly or disabled.
