10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)				
We collect, preserve, and interpret the history of Frederick County, Maryland and its local communities to facilitate continuous learning and inspire critical thinking. We accept and pursue objects, documents, photographs, and other historical artifacts and materials that help convey the diverse narrative of the Countys cities and towns, industries, and people that have defined the Countys history since 1748.				

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

For the past two decades, the existing preservation and storage facility has been housed in a 70-year-old, cinder block shop-building that was adapted for Heritage Fredericks use in 2003. The facility capacity is exhausted and lacks expansion space; existing storage racks contribute to an inefficient use of space; collection processing and conservation space does not exist. Significantly, moisture and climate control issues are continuous and substantial. The development of a new Heritage Preservation Center for serving Frederick County is the most important step for the sustainable preservation of the community's social, economic, and cultural artifacts. The new facility concept will address deficiencies existing at the current site. In addition, we envision the new facility offering dedicated preservation space to accommodate storage and maintenance for peer historical organizations in the community.
